SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

Springwater Trail High School, accredited by the Northwest Association of Accredited Schools (NAAS), is one of the three four-year high schools in the Gresham-Barlow School District #10JT. Gresham is located twelve miles east of Portland, Oregon and includes both suburban and rural areas. STHS is a magnet high school catering to students interested in middle college, small learning communities, authentic learning opportunities, and career-focused education. Students choosing STHS are willing to sacrifice a broad selection of electives in order to benefit from smaller class sizes in a more personal environment. Springwater Trails attendance area includes both high schools and students are accepted by application only. The District attendance area has a population of approximately 90,000, serving over 11,000 students in nineteen schools. Springwater Trail High School enrollment is maintained at approximately 180 students, averaging 35 graduates annually. Approximately 51% of our students receive Free & Reduced Lunch.

Scholastic excellence and student achievement have been the pursuit of Springwater Trail High School. A highly qualified faculty teaches a rigorous academic program. These diverse activities have enabled students to become academically engaged, while broadening their horizons and enriching their lives.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

The Gresham-Barlow School district diploma requires the following 25 credits for graduation:

PROFICIENCY GRADING

Springwater uses a proficiency-based grading process in many classes. Students progress through the curriculum by demonstrating proficiency in the subject area, based on criteria tied directly to standards.

GRADING SYSTEM

The school operates on a semester system with seven 55-minute classes per day. Our credit represents the work for two semesters, totaling 36 weeks. One half-credit represents the work for one semester, totaling 18 weeks. Class rank is based on all subjects taken for a letter grade without weighting. All students enrolled in the class are considered in determining class rank. GPA selects our Valedictorian/Salutatorian.

Post-Secondary

Counseling and school faculty work with students throughout their four years to develop and adjust a personal education plan that focuses on post-secondary success. Approximately 20% of students plan to enter a 4-year institution and 25% plan to enter a two-year institution. Graduates also enter military service, trade schools, and the work force.
